Exam Instructions and Information:

- When considering NCAA rules, assume that **no** NAIA or NJCAA modifications are in effect.
- The term “scoring section” refers to the lines where the serves are recorded. The term “running score section” refers to the vertical score column in the center of the scoresheet.
- “Team S” refers to the serving team. “Team R” refers to the receiving team.
- Unless otherwise noted, all questions apply to non-deciding sets.

Part I

DIRECTIONS: Read each situation carefully and decide whether the statement is true (T) or false (F). Write either “T” or “F” in the space provided.

- _____ 1. The scorekeeper may use either pen or pencil for all scorekeeping functions, including pre- and post-set information, as well as scoring each set.
- _____ 2. At the start of each set, the scorekeeper and assistant scorekeeper should verify the player positions on the court while the second referee is verifying the players’ starting positions.
- _____ 3. Individual and delay sanctions remain in force for the entire match.
- _____ 4. A libero replacement is allowed immediately after a rally is stopped and replayed due to an errant ball entering the court, which interfered with play.
- _____ 5. If a coach inquires directly with the scorekeeper to verify the number of substitutions or timeouts that the team has used, the scorekeeper should provide the requested information to the coach.
- _____ 6. Prior to every service contact, the scorekeeper and assistant scorekeeper should visually confirm that the player serving the ball is the correct server.
- _____ 7. When entering line judges’ names on the scoresheet, Line Judge 1 is the line judge to the right of the second referee since that line judge is on the bench side of the court.
- _____ 8. An exceptional substitution counts as a team substitutions provided the team has a substitution remaining. If the team has no team substitutions remaining, the exceptional substitution is still permitted.
- _____ 9. The libero has served in position 4 in the current set. The assistant scorekeeper should notify the second referee immediately if the libero, who is currently on the court, moves to the service position to replace the next server in position 1 in the service order.

- _____ 10. A circle (or triangle if the libero is serving) is drawn in the scoring section at the moment the first referee whistles to authorize service.
- _____ 11. The scorekeeper notifies the second referee when a team has used its 12th, 13th, 14th and 15th team substitutions.
- _____ 12. When a player is replaced by exceptional substitution, the injured player's number is circled in the *Players' Numbers* column, and the substitution notation is circled in the *Scoring* section.
- _____ 13. If a team receives a delay warning in a set, a subsequent improper request in that same set must be sanctioned as a delay penalty.
- _____ 14. When the scorekeeper identifies a wrong server, she/he should immediately sound a buzzer to notify the referees of the rotation fault.
- _____ 15. Information about points canceled by the referees should be recorded in the *COMMENTS* section of the scoresheet.

- _____ 16. After the scorekeeper receives a team's lineup for the first set, which of the following is the scorekeeper NOT required to do:
- A) Confirm that the coach or captain has signed the lineup.
 - B) Verify that a libero has been indicated.
 - C) Verify with each coach whether the libero will serve and in which position in the service order.
 - D) Confirm all of the team's coaches are listed.
- _____ 17. Which of the following must be transferred to the far right side of the scoresheet at the change of courts in a deciding set?
- A) The last action in the *Scoring* section for the team on the left.
 - B) The substitution count for the team on the left.
 - C) The last score in the *Running Score* column for the team on the left.
 - D) None of the above.
- _____ 18. The letter "M" should be written in the *Running Score* column in which of the following situations?
- A) Points are canceled because of a wrong server.
 - B) The referee changes a decision from "out of bounds" to "touch" after the scorekeeper has already recorded the point on the scoresheet.
 - C) The scorekeeper incorrectly records the result of the rally.
 - D) All of the above.
- _____ 19. Which of the following is NOT true regarding the submission of team lineups at the start of the match?
- A) Changes may be made to the submitted lineups without penalty or substitution until the one-minute mark on the clock timing pre-match warm-ups.
 - B) Lineups cannot be released to statisticians, announcers, etc., until the one-minute mark on the clock timing pre-match warm-ups.
 - C) For the first set, the scorekeeper and assistant scorekeeper should wait until the one-minute mark on the clock timing pre-match warm-ups before entering the lineups on the scoresheet and the libero tracking sheet.
 - D) The team lineups for Set 1 are due at the three-minute mark on the clock timing pre-match warm-ups.

- _____ 20. Which of the following best describes the procedure for recording a double replacement on the Libero Tracking Sheet when the libero, in the set for player #5, replaces player #1 in the service position, with players #1 and #5 exchanging in the replacement zone?
- A) Slash #5 and write #1 next to it.
 - B) Write #5 next to the L (which was recorded when the libero replaced #5), and write an L next to #1.
 - C) Write #1 next to #5.
 - D) Slash the L and write #5 next to the L (which was recorded when the libero replaced #5), then slash #1 and write an L next to it.
- _____ 21. Which of the following misconduct sanctions would also result in a point and the serve being awarded to the opponent?
- A) Red card.
 - B) Red and yellow cards held together.
 - C) Red and yellow cards held apart.
 - D) All of the above.
- _____ 22. During a timeout, the assistant scorekeeper performs which of the following?
- A) Notify the second referee of the status of each team's libero (on or off the court) when the timeout was called.
 - B) Confirm with the scorekeeper the total number of substitutions used by each team.
 - C) Verify that the same six players, who were on the court for each team when the timeout was called, return to the court at the conclusion of the timeout before any substitutions or libero replacements can occur.
 - D) All of the above are responsibilities of the assistant scorekeeper during a timeout.
- _____ 23. Which of the following is NOT a responsibility of the assistant scorekeeper?
- A) Recording the serving position of the libero.
 - B) Tracking all substitutions by each team.
 - C) Tracking each team's service order.
 - D) All of the above are responsibilities of the assistant scorekeeper.
- _____ 24. Which of the following is true regarding the redesignation of an injured libero?
- A) The redesignation must take place immediately after the injury occurs.
 - B) A libero replaced by redesignation may not participate in the remainder of the match.
 - C) The redesignation does not need to take place immediately after the injury, but can take place at the discretion of the coach or captain.
 - D) Both A and B are true.
- _____ 25. With 2:00 remaining in the timed warm-up period, Team B's player #11, who is listed as a starter on the lineup sheet, injures her ankle and cannot start the match. The Team B coach requests that #11 be replaced by #18 on the lineup sheet. What is the correct procedure for the scorekeeper to handle this situation?
- A) Record "S 18/11" in the *Scoring* section of Team B's first server, slash the number "11" in Team B's *PLAYERS' NUMBERS* section and write "18" next to it, and slash the number "1" in Team B's *SUBSTITUTIONS* section.
 - B) Circle "11" in the *PLAYERS' NUMBERS* section of Team B, record "18" next to the circled "11", record "0-0 Exceptional Sub, Team B, 18 for injured 11" in the *COMMENTS* section.
 - C) Cross out ("X") #11 in Team B's *PLAYERS' NUMBERS* section and write #18 next to it. A similar correction should be made to Team B's lineup sheet.
 - D) Notify the second referee and administer the change as a regular substitution after the second referee has checked the players' positions on the court at the start of the set.


Part III

DIRECTIONS: Using the lineups and scoresheet sections provided on the following page, read each statement below and enter the requested information in the appropriate section(s).

26. WESTERN STATE is the Home team and they have selected the bench to the scorekeeper's right. EAST RIVER wins the coin toss and elects to receive. Record each team's lineup.
Enter the names of the line judges in the appropriate boxes (below) as well. The line judge to the first referee's right is Bea Sharp, and the line judge to the second referee's right is Jim Flagger.
27. The first server for WESTERN STATE serves and scores a point. On the next serve, the server commits a foot fault.
28. EAST RIVER substitutes #7 for #21. EAST RIVER now serves for three points.
29. WESTERN STATE requests, and is granted, a timeout.
EAST RIVER serves the ball out of bounds.
30. The WESTERN STATE libero replaces the current server and serves for two points.
31. An EAST RIVER player deliberately unties her shoes to delay the resumption of play. The first referee holds a yellow card against their wrist and indicates the sanction will be against EAST RIVER.
The WESTERN STATE libero serves the ball into the net.
32. EAST RIVER substitutes #9 for #18, and WESTERN STATE substitutes #5 for #22.
EAST RIVER serves for two points.
33. Before the next serve, the WESTERN STATE captain argues with the first referee about a judgment decision in the last rally. The first referee assesses an individual warning (yellow card) to the WESTERN STATE captain.
34. EAST RIVER serves again. During the rally, the WESTERN STATE captain yells at the first referee. The first referee stops play, displays a red card, and indicates the sanction will be against the WESTERN STATE captain.
EAST RIVER serves the ball again and loses the rally.
35. Clearly after the first referee whistles for the next serve, the EAST RIVER coach requests a substitution. That request is denied (without a whistle). EAST RIVER wins the rally and afterwards, the referees assess an improper request to EAST RIVER.
36. EAST RIVER serves for two points. EAST RIVER serves again, and during that rally, WESTERN STATE #9 is injured and the referees stop play and declare a replay. WESTERN STATE has no legal substitute on the bench, so the coach requests #22 to enter as an exceptional substitute for #9.
EAST RIVER serves and loses the rally.
37. WESTERN STATE serves and wins the point. At the end of that rally, it is discovered that the EAST RIVER libero is injured and is unable to continue play. The EAST RIVER coach redesignates #12 as a new libero for the set.
WESTERN STATE serves and loses the rally.


GAME 1 LIBERO 6

38. WESTERN STATE is the Home team and they select the bench to the scorekeeper's right. EAST RIVER wins the coin toss and elects to receive. Enter the appropriate information, including team lineups, on the Libero Tracking Sheet.
39. After the second referee checks the lineups, the WESTERN STATE libero replaces #22 and the EAST RIVER libero replaces #5.
40. WESTERN STATE serves and loses the rally.
41. EAST RIVER substitutes #9 for #18. EAST RIVER then serves and loses the rally.
42. WESTERN STATE serves and loses the rally.
43. The EAST RIVER libero, who is on the court, goes directly to the service zone. EAST RIVER #5 and #9 cross in the Libero Replacement Zone. The EAST RIVER libero serves and loses the rally.
44. WESTERN STATE #22 replaces the libero, then WESTERN STATE substitutes #12 for #22. WESTERN STATE serves and scores a point.

WESTERN STATE serves and loses the rally.
47. The EAST RIVER libero, who is on the bench, replaces the next server and prepares to serve. The EAST RIVER libero then serves and scores a point. The EAST RIVER libero then serves the ball out of bounds.
48. WESTERN STATE serves and scores a point. The teams change courts.
49. The EAST RIVER coach then requests, and is granted, a timeout.
50. WESTERN STATE serves and loses the rally.
