- To be PAVO-certified, scorekeepers must join a PAVO-affiliated local association (called a "board"). A list of PAVO-affiliated boards is available on the PAVO website (www.pavo.org, click on "LOCAL CHAPTERS"). PAVO charges annual dues of \$20 to Scorekeeper members, although local boards may charge a small additional fee for local programs. Current regular (referee) members &/or Line Judge-members who already belong to a local board do not have to pay additional dues to certify as a scorekeeper.
- For initial certification, submit this form with **three** recommendation signatures to the Chair of the local PAVO board you join. The current-year exam must be graded, corrected to 100%, and signed by an approved instructor, and submitted to the local board chair as well.
- To maintain certification, annually submit the examination (graded, corrected to 100%, and signed by an approved instructor), and this recommendation form signed by **one** approved instructor to the chair of the local PAVO board you join.
